The Order of Holy Communion

Prepare to Receive the LORD's Supper/Holy Communion

When we come to the altar during the LORD's Supper/Holy Communion:

Our congregation requests the potential communion recipient be baptized in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Ghost.

We invite you to read and understand 1 Corinthians 11:17-34, Matthew 28:16-20 and Mark 14:23-25 for your understanding of the Holy Communion.

We receive Christ's Body and Blood in, with and under the bread and the wine, for the forgiveness of sins, united in the fellowship of faith and faithful in Christ, Christ's presence and peace.

Here our LORD gives to us His Body and Blood, His sacrifice for us, for the forgiveness of all our sins.

The Eucharist

We declare ourselves to be people of the Lord's Passion, Death and Resurrection!

We have come to share what the Lord has prepared for us.

For our Savior took the bad news of sin and guilt and transformed them to good news through His dying and rising for us.

We are here to celebrate the good news and the presence of Christ with us.

Our Lord Jesus Christ, on the night when He was betrayed, took the bread, blessed it, and broke it. He said to His disciples-

"Take, eat; this is my body, which is given for you.

This do in remembrance of me."

In the same way also He took the cup after supper, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, saying,

Drink of it all of you; this cup is the New Testament in My blood, which is shed for you for the forgiveness of sins.

This do, as often as you drink it in remembrance of Me.

The Peace of the Lord be with you always.
